



Little Corner SchoolHouse to Open Third Location in Brookline

Little Corner SchoolHouse (www.littlecornerschoolhouse.com), a Brookline-based early childhood education center, will open a new location this summer, co-owned by Ina Brother and first in the partnership with co-owner AJSRE. Applications are now being accepted for enrollment.

“With the need for quality educational facilities for children,” said Brother, Executive Director of Little Corner SchoolHouse. “Our new location in Brookline will be able to serve more families that work in or near to Boston.”

The Little Corner SchoolHouse was founded in 1989 and includes infant, toddler, preschool and pre-K programs. The child-centered focus promotes growth in all areas of development including social, emotional, cognitive and physical. Part of the curriculum includes planned field trips, music, science, culinary arts and swimming lessons. With two locations already in place, the third early education center is scheduled to open summer 2011.
